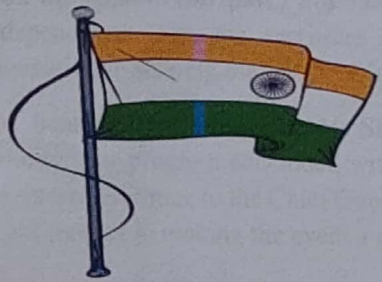

79th INDEPENDENCE DAY

India's Independence Day, celebrated on August 15th each year, marks the nation's liberation from British colonial rule. As the clock struck midnight on August 14, 1947, the Indian tricolor flag replaced the Union Jack (the national flag of the United Kingdom), marking the birth of a free country. Jawaharlal Nehru, independent India's first prime minister, addressed the Constituent Assembly with his famous "Tryst with Destiny" speech. Thousands of people gathered in Delhi for the occasion. Across the country, people celebrated with joy, music, and prayer, despite the shadow of partition.

The 79th Independence Day of India was celebrated with great enthusiasm and patriotic fervor at **Anandi Pharmacy College** on **15th August 2025**. 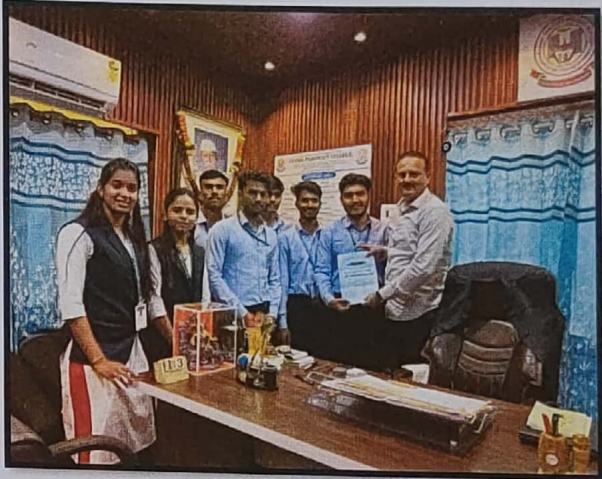
