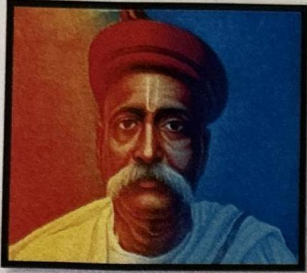

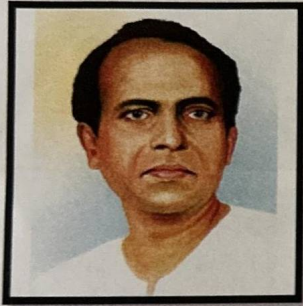


LOKMANYA TILAK AND ANNABHAU SATHE JAYANTI



Bal Gangadhar Tilak, also known as Lokmanya Tilak, was a prominent Indian nationalist, teacher, social reformer, lawyer, and independence activist. He was born on July 23, 1856, and is known for his role in the Indian independence movement. Tilak is considered one of the first and strongest advocates for Swaraj (self-rule) and a key figure in the Indian National Congress. He was also a pioneer in using public platforms to mobilize the masses and promote nationalism. "Swaraj is my birthright, and I shall have it!", his leadership in the Lal, Bal, Pal triumvirate, and

his use of public celebrations like Ganesh Chaturthi to unite people against British rule.



Annabhau Sathe Jayanti is celebrated on August 1st. It commemorates the birth anniversary of Annabhau Sathe, a renowned Marathi writer, poet, and social reformer from Maharashtra, India. He was born on August 1, 1920. Annabhau Sathe is celebrated for his contributions to literature and his dedication to social reform, particularly for the upliftment of marginalized communities. He authored numerous novels, short stories, and songs, and was a prominent figure in the Dalit literature movement. He is also known as "Lok Shahir" (People's Poet) for his popular folk songs and plays. A legendary social reformer, folk poet, and writer, Annabhau Sathe gave voice to the oppressed through his powerful literature and songs. His contribution to Dalit literature and working-class movements in Maharashtra is immense. His legacy continues to guide youth toward social justice and equality.
