INDIRA PRIYADARSHINI GANDHI JAYANTI



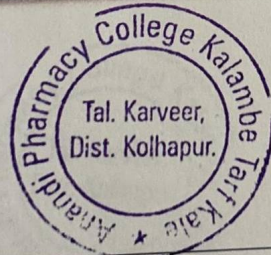
Indira Priyadarshini Gandhi was the first and, to date, the only woman Prime Minister of India. Born on 19 November 1917 in Allahabad, she was the daughter of Jawaharlal Nehru, India's first Prime Minister. Growing up in a politically active family, she was deeply influenced by the freedom struggle and often participated in activities supporting India's independence. Indira Gandhi became Prime Minister in 1966 and served three consecutive terms, and later a fourth term, making her one of India's longest-serving leaders. She was known for her strong and decisive leadership, especially during significant events such as the Green Revolution, which helped India become self-sufficient in food grains, and the 1971 Indo-Pak War, which led to the creation of Bangladesh. Her leadership style was both admired and controversial, especially after the Emergency period (1975–1977). Despite political challenges, she remained a powerful figure in Indian politics until her assassination on 31 October 1984. Indira Gandhi is remembered today for her bold decisions, influential personality, and lasting impact on India's political and economic development.
